This position will work closely with Hazon's JOFEE Fellowship Director and JOFEE Program Associate. Your responsibilities will include assisting with some or all of the following:

- Developing training curricula and programmatic resources for JOFEE Fellows
- Planning the JOFEE Network Gathering, taking place June 6-9 at Isabella Freedman Jewish Retreat Center
- Producing content for a national JOFEE brochure
- Developing a new JOFEE leadership training program
- Working on new joint recruitment efforts for Hazon's immersive JOFEE programs:
 Adamah, Teva, and the JOFEE Fellowship

We are looking for interns with the following skills and qualities:

- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Exceptional writing, editing, and proofreading skills
- Detail-oriented and conscientious
- Ability to work independently on projects and work collaboratively with a small staff
- Comfortable prioritizing multiple tasks, problem solving, and being creative with limited resources
- Strong research skills and an ability to synthesize information into an easily understandable format
- Sharp analytical thinking
- Creativity and a desire to take initiative and suggest fresh ideas
- Previous experience in writing and editing, food work, or nonprofit communications
- Experience working with WordPress or other web platform
- Experience working with Adobe InDesign, or demonstrated capacity to learn quickly
- Current graduate or undergraduate students in Jewish Education / Jewish studies strongly encouraged to apply

Dates and Compensation

Ideal start date is early March 2016. Internship end date will be early to mid-June – ideally no earlier than June 10, 2016. Continuation as JOFEE Summer Intern may also be discussed pending interest and availability.

The JOFEE Spring Intern will be paid a modest stipend, with specifics to be discussed based on weekly work-hours commitment. Registration and lodging fees will be fully covered for attendance at the JOFEE Network Gathering, June 6-9, at Hazon's Isabella Freedman Jewish Retreat Center in the Berkshire Mountains of Connecticut.
