



Dining Hall Server

The dining hall server will be based at Isabella Freedman Jewish Retreat Center in Falls Village and will report to the Associate Director of Food Services. The dining hall server is needed for a dynamic farm to table kitchen at a busy retreat center. This position requires flexible schedule, nights, holidays, and weekends.

Responsibilities include:

- Run food from the kitchen to the buffet line and keep the buffet clean, replenished, and presentable
- Serve guests who have specific dietary needs and restrictions
- Maintain and respect Kashrut (Kosher laws) in the kitchen and dining room as instructed by the Mashgiach (Kosher Supervisor)
- Assist guests with food requests and address questions and concerns in a kind, helpful, and respectful manner
- Maintain a consistent and professional level of customer service and ensure that guests have an enjoyable dining experience
- Assist with food preparation and adhere to food safety and handling requirements
- Assist with setting up, cleaning/breaking down, and resetting dining spaces
- Clean and stock the coffee bar and brew coffee when needed
- Receive and put away orders
- Clean and organize refrigerators, storage rooms, and workspaces
- Assist porters, kitchen staff, and directors when needed
- Attend staff meetings and staff training
- Adhere to standard operating procedures and perform other necessary daily tasks at the discretion of the Associate Director of Food Services

Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED preferred
- Banquet server/wait staff experience and kosher knowledge a plus
- Excellent customer service and communication skills
- Positive attitude, willingness and desire to learn

- Ability to multitask and work as a team in a high volume and fast paced environment
- Punctual, organized, flexible, and able to work independently
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs and carry up/down stairs, multiple times daily
- Ability to walk and stand for long periods of time
