- You must be able to commit to 10-15 hours of work per week.
- As a volunteer, you will not be paid, however, if you are a student, academic credit is available.
- Volunteers must have their own computer, phone, and work space.
- We will be accepting applications on a rolling basis until the Volunteer opportunities are filled. We thank you for your interest in volunteering with Hazon. Due to high volume, only those candidates selected for an interview will be contacted.

Jewish Youth Climate Movement (JYCM): Digital Design and Data Volunteer

The Jewish Youth Climate Movement (JYCM) was founded by Hazon in 2020. We are dedicated to mitigating climate change by empowering teens, mobilizing our communities and taking action. JYCM believes in using Jewish values as a motivation to create a more equitable and sustainable world for all.

Hazon is seeking a part-time volunteer position with Hazon's National Programs team for 12-15 hours per week from June 14, 2021 - August 20, 2021. This volunteer opportunity is remote and will be supervised by Liana Rothman, National Programs Manager.

Your responsibilities will include:

Support Maintenance and Growth of JYCM Visual Strategy, Social Media, and Online Presence

- Work with the Communications team to create a strong JYCM brand and visual strategy.
- Create a JYCM style guide to be used by the movement.
- Keep the Communications team accountable to post on social media and gain followers and attention every week (instagram, facebook, twitter, newsletter). Take on some amount of posting each week while teens are at camp and busy over the summer.
- Support planning of online fundraising campaigns.
- Support the Communications team to center DEI (diversity, equity, and inclusion) in all work.
- Support the Communications team in filling out the JYCM website -- creating a "join us" page with stories and testimonials, videos, link to the application form, info about becoming a Kvutzah/Chapter.
- General upkeep and support of the website.
- Support the newsletter team in content development, editing and drafting the monthly newsletter in Salsa.
- Expand the JYCM portal's array of toolkits by creating toolkits that summarize each JYCM training from the Spring Jewish Youth Climate Activism training series and from the JYCM presentation bank.

Administrative Support

- Support logistical planning of the Summer Leadership Programming for the national leadership board.
- Maintain clear tracking of program participation and impact through effective data systems and intentional digital recruitment designed to increase and improve JYCM's engagement.

Weekly meetings

- 30 minute check-in and thought partnership session once a week with Liana to touch base on how things are going. Space for questions and concerns.
- Supporting the summer teams in their ongoing meetings/projects.



As a volunteer, you will learn about the spectrum of Hazon's work. In addition, there will be opportunities including:

- Learning with Hazon staff about Hazon at weekly staff meetings.
- Attending meetings with other Hazon staff during the rotation.
- Opportunities to present your work to Hazon staff and partners.
