- Planning and running all programs during scheduled cabin activity periods;
- Planning and running one chug (elective) per week;
- Setting up the Teva area (planting, starter plants and seeds, soil care, and activity planning) during staff orientation and maintaining this area as a safe environment for participants during the summer.
