Each summer Hazon welcomes a cohort of interns to work in our New York office on a wide variety of projects. We seek interns who are interested in the intersection between Jewish tradition and contemporary environmental issues, who work well with others and independently, and enjoy a flexible workspace. At the end of the internship program, each intern will receive a stipend of \$1000.

Your responsibilities will include:

- Supporting the revision of food-related resources such as our Adamah Reader, Food Festival Manual and program activity guides, and creating a system of feedback and evaluation
- Communicating with constituents about how they have used our materials, and how we can support their programming goals
- Working on a strategic plan for distribution and marketing of our materials
- Researching and developing a new food policy and food audit program
- Working on our website's food-related pages

We are looking for interns with the following skills and qualities:

- A background in education and/or curriculum development
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Exceptional writing, editing, and proofreading skills
- Detail-oriented and conscientious
- Ability to work independently on projects as well as work collaboratively with a small staff
- Comfortable prioritizing multiple tasks, problem solving, and being creative with limited resources
- Strong research skills and an ability to synthesize information into an easily understandable format
- Sharp analytical thinking
- Creativity and a desire to take initiative and suggest fresh ideas
- Experience working with a WordPress or other web platform
- Previous experience in writing and editing, food work, or nonprofit communications a plus

The intern must be able to commit to 30-40 hours of work per week. The internship runs from June 1-August 6, 2015.
