Job Description

- Provide logistical support to educators, including but not limited to set-up and breakdown of the program, preparing program supplies, maintenance of supplies and ordering new supplies
- Fill in as needed and as time and skills permit in educational opportunities, including but not limited to: song-leading, tefilla coordination, group programs, and electives
