Primary Responsibilities:

Support the data management and administrative needs of JYCM:

- Do research to determine a combination of databases/systems that meet JYCM needs.
- Data Management will include:
 - o Identify potential members, track members, and maintain engagement with members.
 - Track information about our Kvutzot (Chapter).
 - Track information about our programs and campaigns.
 - Identify potential donors, track donors and donations, and maintain engagement with donors and prospective donors.
 - Create and maintain comprehensive data tracking systems using spreadsheets and other tools.
 - Create and implement a donor engagement plan.

Fundraising:

- Lead the prospect research to support the expansion of JYCM with the priority to become a funded program in 2021, while working with Hazon's Fundraising team to support grant research and proposals.
- Brainstorm fundraising ideas and campaigns and support their implementation.

Website Development:

• Support the Marketing and Communications team by inputting data and information on the JYCM website. Create a "join us" page with testimonials, videos, a link to the application form, and information about becoming a Kvutzah (Chapter).

Support Maintenance and Growth of JYCM Visual Strategy, Social Media, and Online Presence:

- Work with the Marketing and Communications Team to create a strong JYCM brand, as a program of Hazon, and keep the Marketing and Communications team accountable to postings on social media.
 - Help gain followers and attention through instagram, facebook, twitter, and our newsletter.
