



Hakhel in Ukraine - Future Plans (July to December, 2022)

The Power of Community in Face of Violence and Crisis

Hakhel is Hazon's **Jewish Intentional Communities Incubator**, in partnership with Israel's Ministry of Diaspora Affairs. It works to **revitalize Jewish life** by building communities of unaffiliated Jews around the world and includes over 130 communities in 30 countries and 6 continents.

Five of these communities are based in Ukraine, in the cities of Lviv, Kiev, Dnepro, Odessa, and Harkiv. On top of these, Hakhel works with additional Russian speaking communities in Belarus, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Austria, Germany, Spain, Australia and the US. Hakhel has been working with these communities since 2018 and plans to continue working with them in years to come, hence investing in them yields an **enduring impact**.

The purpose of the infrastructure we built over the years is to **strengthen Jewish life**, yet Hakhel's work proves that sustainable communities are effective in **building resiliency** as well. Furthermore, building a **network** of communities multiplies their impact.

Despite the decline in global interest, **the war and crisis in Ukraine is not over yet**. Towns are running out of basic supplies, millions of refugees are still wandering around Europe and other countries, rehabilitation efforts have not even begun, and are expected to take years.

Hakhel's work continues on the ground, and in the next six months we plan to focus on:

- 1) **Food and medication deliveries** inside Ukraine, to communities in distress.
- 2) Increased **professional mentorship** and support to the Ukrainian communities, in order to strengthen and rebuild them.
- 3) **Networking events** for the Russian speaking network, as a second support circle for the Ukrainian communities.
- 4) Inviting **Ukrainian representatives to global Hakhel events**, to keep them connected, inspired and empowered.
